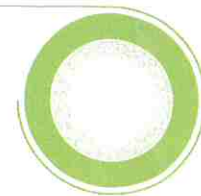

Postgraduate ITT Fees and Funding



Fees 2018-19

If you are studying on a postgraduate initial teacher training (ITT) course, you may have to pay tuition fees. Tuition fees may vary according to the course that you are studying.

Course	Fee
Full-time Postgraduate (Provider Led)	£9,250
Part-time Postgraduate (Provider Led)	£4,625 payable in year 1 and in year 2 = total of £9,250
Full-time School Based (School Direct Unsalaries)	£5,960-£9,250
Full-time School Based (School Direct Salaries)	QTS only fee paid by School, fees payable for top up to PGCE £3,290

*trainees in Secondary Maths could receive up to £32,000 in total with a bursary of £20,000 or a Scholarship of £22,000 with additional payments of £10,000 after tax once in teaching. The additional funds will be paid as two additional early-career payments of £5,000 each in the third and fifth year of teaching once qualified. There may be additional enhancements to these payments if you teach in specified areas in England.

Trainees with a 2:1 or above can apply for a scholarship from the relevant professional subject association; trainees with a 2:2 can still apply but will need to demonstrate significant relevant experience. Scholarships are awarded in place of a bursary.

Payments

Full-time study

Bursaries and scholarships of £12,000 or less are paid in 10 equal monthly instalments from October to July. Bursaries and scholarships of £15,000 or above will receive 10 equal monthly instalments from October to July with additional payments in February and July, or the final month of the course.

Part-time study

For trainees on flexible courses bursaries are paid in two instalments - 50% upon completion of full course enrolment and 50% upon course completion. For trainees on structured part-time courses the instalments will be spread throughout the duration of study.
